

Youth Leaders of Wabauskang

Since partnering with Right To Play back in October 2011, youth from Wabauskang have been participating in the Youth Leadership Program. The program, which is ran twice weekly by Right To Play Community Mentor Alex Petiquan, enhances leadership skills in youth through fun and interactive workshops. During these workshops the youth are assisted in the planning, leading and assessing of their own community events.





Leadership workshops take place every Tuesday and Thursday at the Community Hall. Since workshops began in October, youth leaders have already organized a successful Remembrance Day feast and are now putting the finishing touches to their second event, a Winter Survival Camp.
